1. Poster of an area with tourism potential in a less developed economic area to be promoted by the project company.
2. Materials for the exhibition of the project (materials of the school's training company, posters, etc.)
3. A presentation of each school that students will make on the first day.
4. In our project there are two activities planned at this meeting:
 - ✓ A15: Debate "Banking versus non-bank financing" (Act of formation for the teaching staff)
 - ✓ A16: Workshop: "Crowdfunding as a source of funding" (Act of formation for the students)
