- a) Have new methodologies been used?



b) Were there mixed international groups?



c) Were there artistic or literary production or exploring new forms of teaching?



d) Were there effective learning experiences?



## e) Were there tangible or intangible results?







# 4. HOW HAS THE COMUNICATION BEEN BETWEEN PARTNER CENTRES? (Value from 0 to 5)



## 5. HAVE NEW TECHNOLOGIES BEEN USED IN THE ACTIVITIES



## 6. VALUE THE COLLABORATIVE WORK IN THE ACTIVITIES (From 0 to 5)





