1. Do you consider that the workshops and collaborative activities carried out during the week contribute to achieve the objectives of our project?

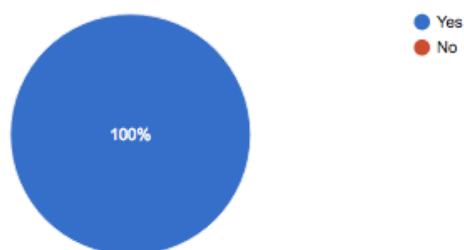

2. Evaluate the collaborative activities in relation with the project. (1 = Poor 2 = Fair 3 = Good 4 = Very good 5 = Excellent)

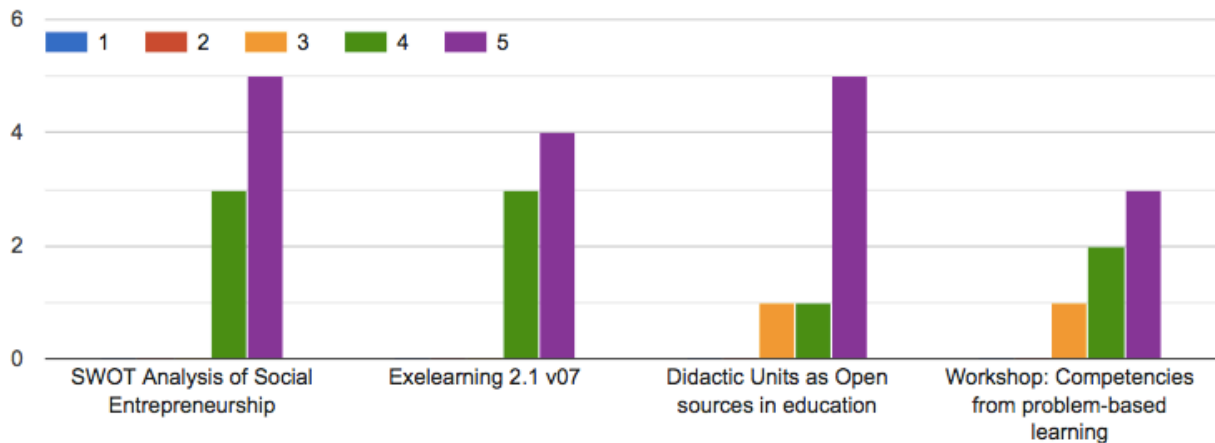

3. Do you consider that the conferences and seminars carried out during the week have been generally adequate to achieve the objectives of our project?

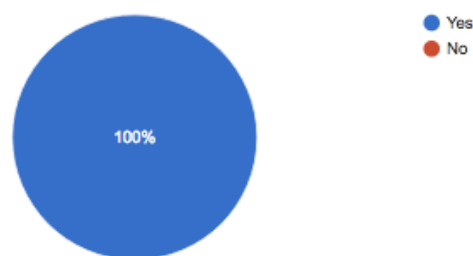

4. Evaluate the following conferences and seminars in relation with the project.(1 = Poor 2 = Fair 3 = Good 4 = Very good 5 = Excellent)

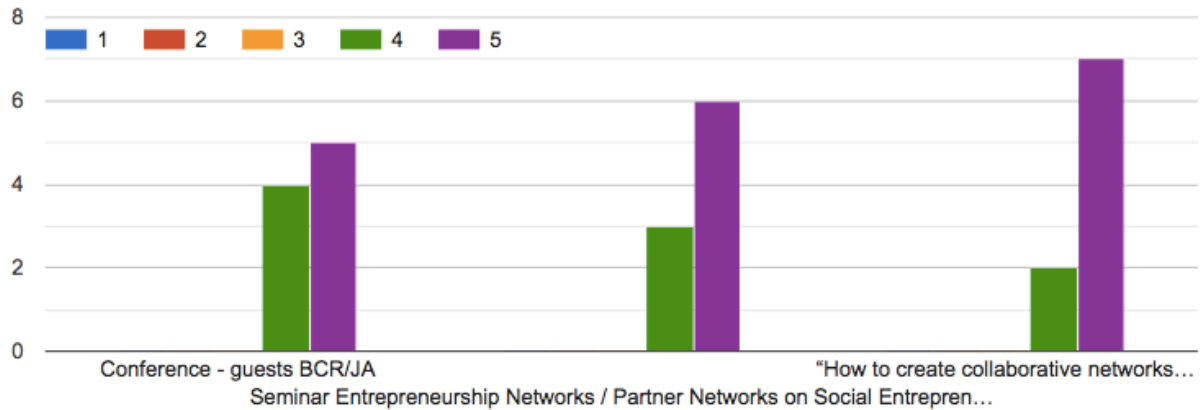

5. Do you consider that the debate about "Connection between competencies in schools and the world of work, examples of good practice" contribute to achieve the objectives of our project?

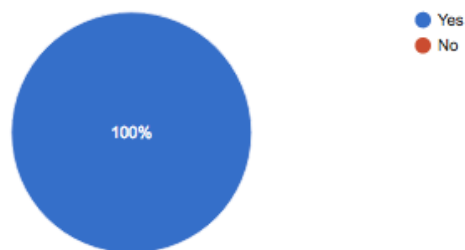

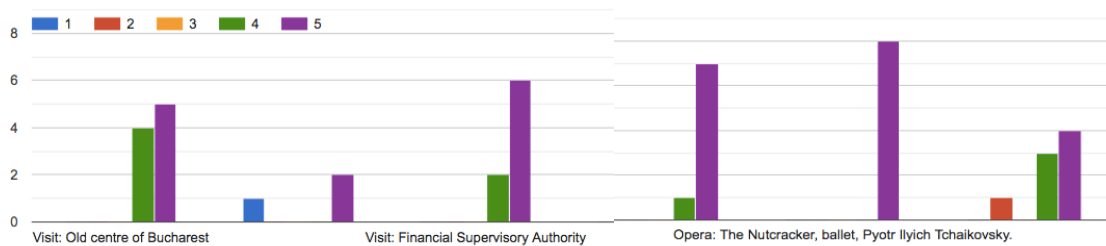
6. Do you consider that the cultural activities carried out during the week contribute to achieve the objectives of our project?

8. What areas of knowledge are integrated into the different activities carried out during the week?

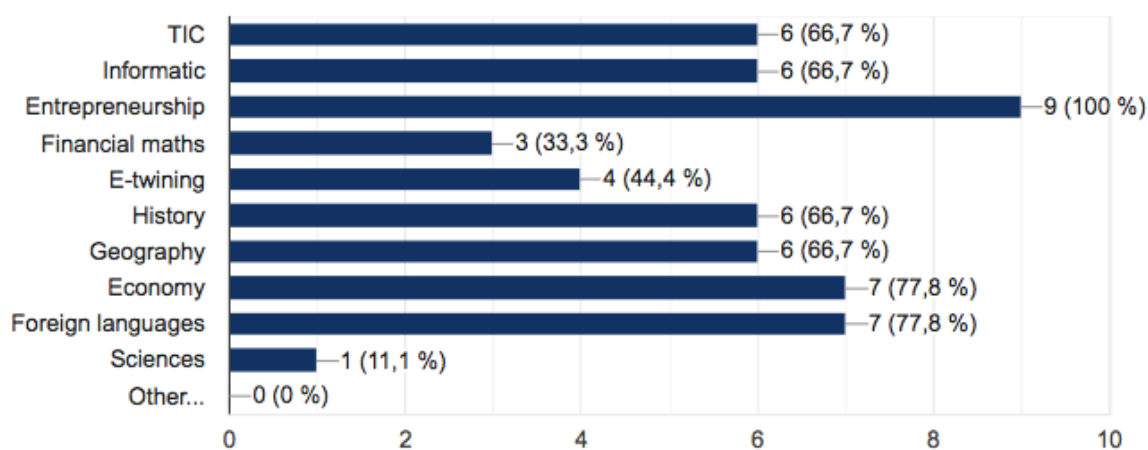

9. Are there any results of the activities carried out during the week?

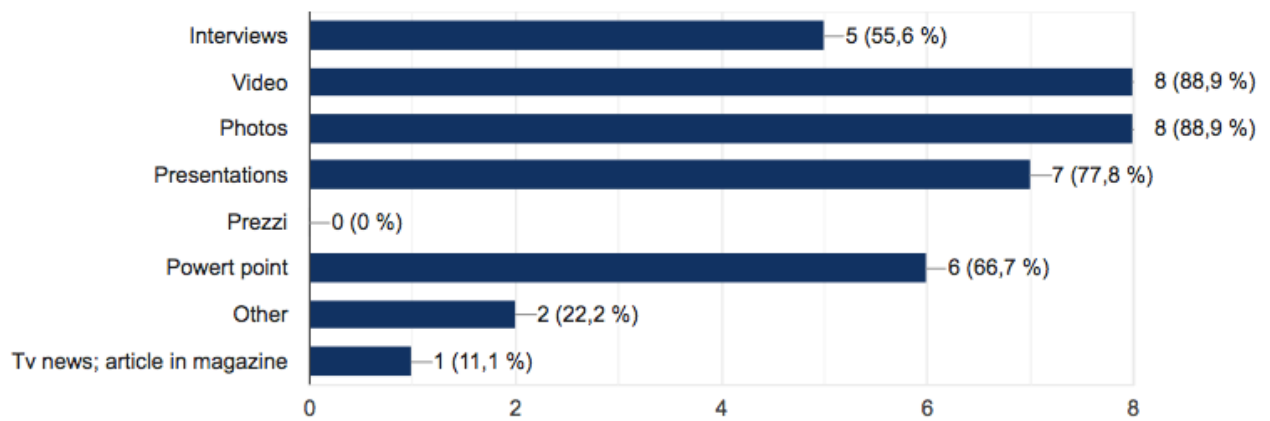

10. Did you know the activities that were planned for the week well in advance?

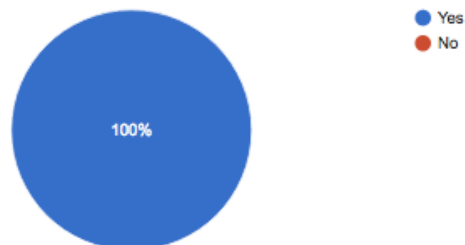

11. Rate the week generally

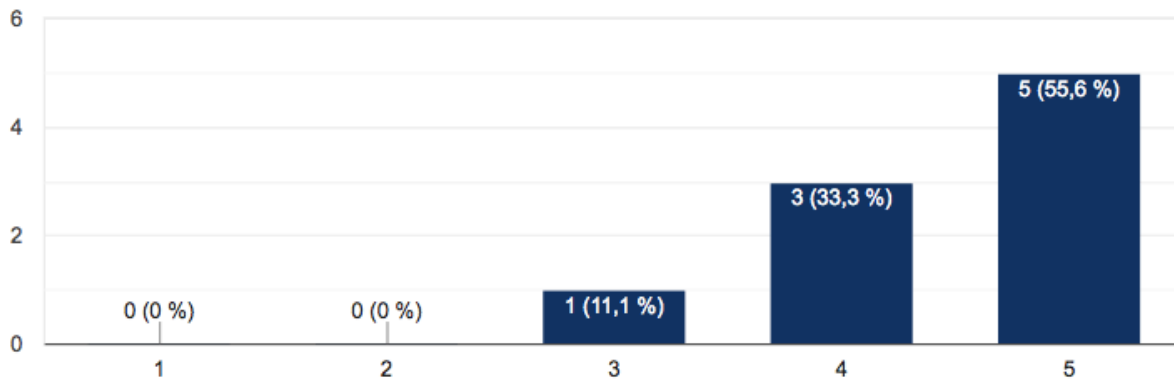
