2. Evaluate the following workshops in relation with the project. (1 = Poor 2 = Fair 3 = Good 4 = Very good 5 = Excellent)

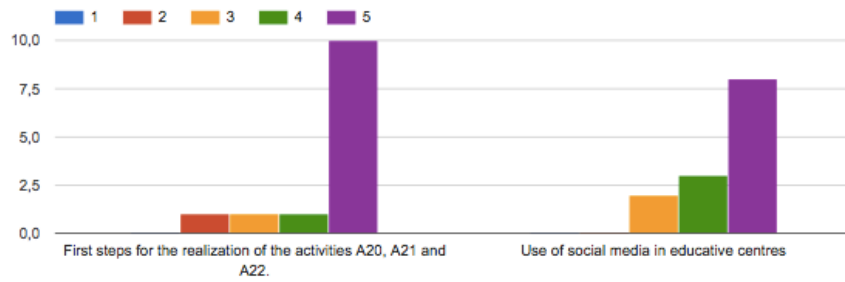

3. Do you consider that the collaboratives activities carried out during the week contribute to achieve the objectives of our project?

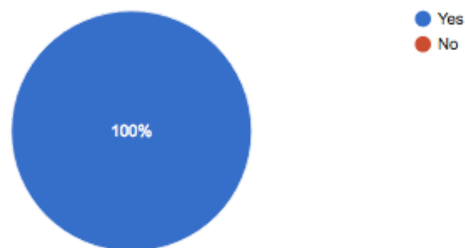

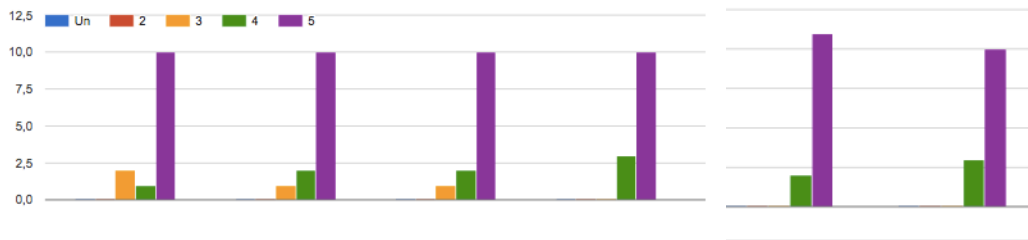

5. Do you consider that the cultural activities carried out during the week contribute to achieve the objectives of our project?

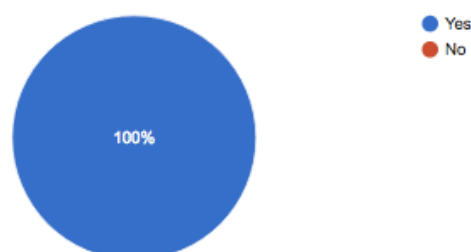

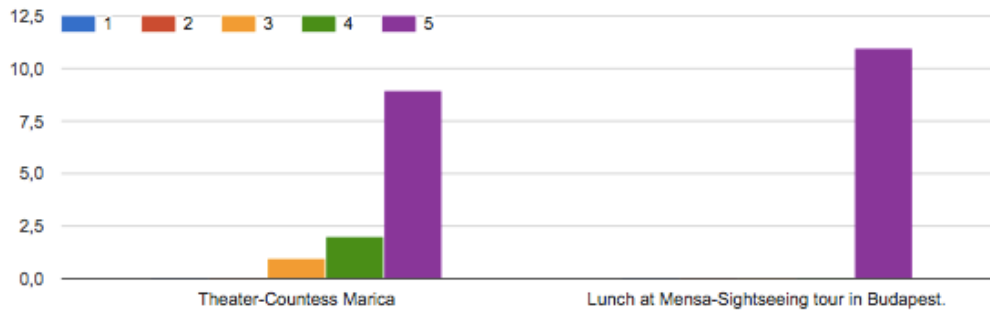

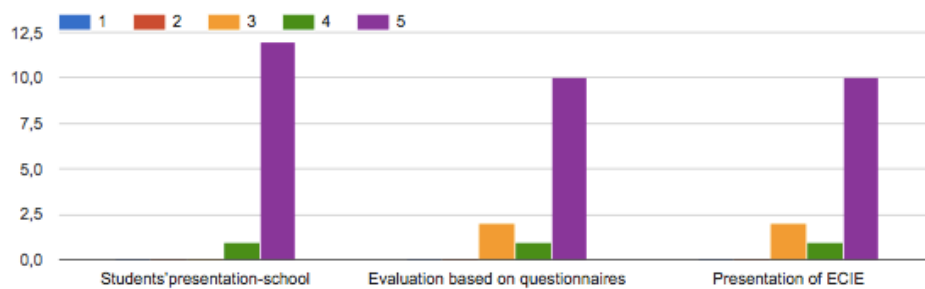

8. What areas of knowledge are integrated into the different activities carried out during the week?

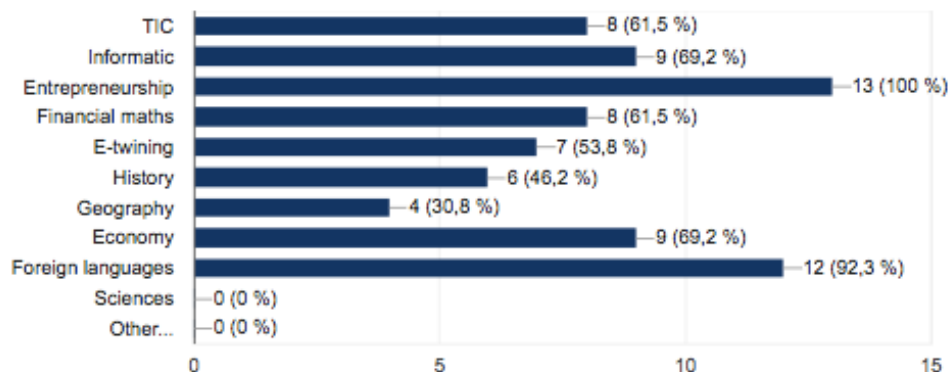

9. Are there any results of the activities carried out during the week?

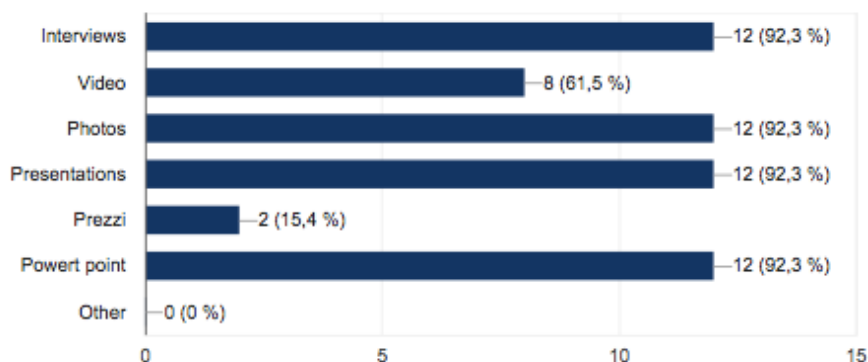

10. Did you know the activities that were planned for the week well in advance?

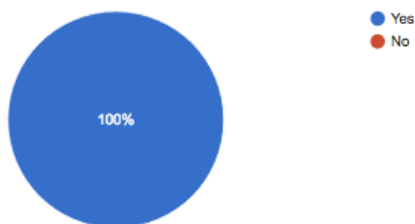

11. Rate the week generally

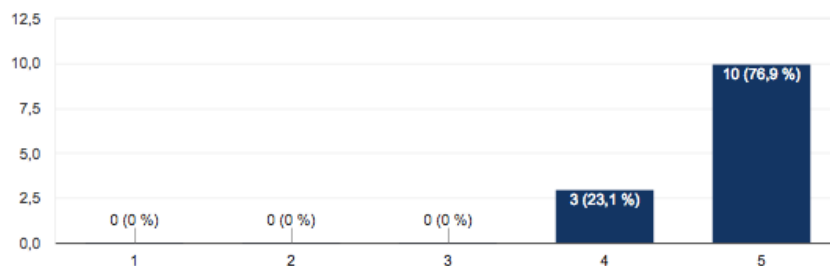
